Chinese Language – Elementary II

Overview

This course is designed for students who already have basic knowledge of the Mandarin Chinese language and looking to further his/her knowledge in Chinese business conversation. It covers commonly used vocabulary words and students are expected to master common writing words (Chinese Character: Han Zi). The course covers daily corporate interactions and business-related social exchanges. Topics include family, work environment, making appointments, social events, and farewells. All classes emphasize business communication: negotiating, socializing, establishing and maintaining good relationships. Beyond language acquisition, each lesson provides students with extensive cultural points to help navigate cultural differences in business and daily life.

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- . Speak Chinese with some fluency on basic conversational topics
- . Achieve a basic level of reading competence
- . Master the writing of 150 words
- . Write short compositions
