

ENGLISH LANGUAGE – INTERMEDIATE I & II

Overview

These courses focus on competency. Their aims are to advance students oral and written communication.

Learning Objectives

At the completion of the two levels, participants should be able to:

- . Read passages of 2-4 paragraphs using decoding skills, vocabulary, and grammar knowledge and other reading strategies.
- . Write and edit simple and basic compound sentences and five to ten sentence paragraphs using level-appropriate grammar and English writing conventions.
- . Appropriately respond to: explanations, conversations, instructions, and narratives of modest length and on familiar topics. Can also appropriately respond to common real-life situations (including phone conversations) to keep a conversation going, including altering language when not understood and asking for clarification when unable to understand.
- . Carry on a conversation and participate in a group discussion relating to familiar, predictable, and everyday topics and future plans using learned vocabulary.

Course Level:	Intermediate level 401 and 402
Course Duration:	2-hours/day (1-2 Months)
Course Format:	Instructor-led course
Target Audience:	These courses are open to all those who are interested in advancing their comprehension and use of the English language.
Prerequisite:	completion of pre-intermediate levels and/or those who can communicate in a range of everyday social and travel contexts.
